

Executive Order No. 14 - 2010

EXECUTIVE ORDER DISCONTINUING THE MONTANA  
PUBLIC VEHICLE FUELING PROGRAM AND ADVISORY COUNCIL

---

WHEREAS, through Executive Order No. 22-92, dated February 22, 1992, then-Governor Stan Stephens established the Montana Public Vehicle Fueling Program and Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Council was established for the purpose of reducing underground fuel storage tanks and publically-owned fueling sites, incorporating commercial fueling sites, and automating fuel payments using fleet card processing; and

WHEREAS, in 1993, the Advisory Council incorporated commercial fueling sites and automated fuel payments using fleet card processing, and by 2009, underground fuel storage tanks and publicly owned fueling sites had been reduced by 2009; and

WHEREAS, the 1992 Executive Order provided that the Advisory Council would remain in effect until terminated by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, the work of the Advisory Council has been completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Brian Schweitzer, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws and the Constitution of the State of Montana, do hereby discontinue the Montana Public Vehicle Fueling Program and Advisory Council and thank the former members of the Council for their important work and public service.

This Order is effective immediately.
