

Executive Order No. 15-2010

EXECUTIVE ORDER ATTACHING THE CONCEALED WEAPONS
ADVISORY COUNCIL TO THE BOARD OF CRIME CONTROL

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. § 45-8-329, directs the governor to establish a council, composed of interested persons to advise the governor on and pursue concealed weapon permit issues; and


WHEREAS, there is no statutory provision indicating to what agency the Concealed Weapons Advisory Council shall be attached for administrative purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Concealed Weapons Advisory Council currently is attached to the Department of Corrections for administrative purposes; and

WHEREAS, having consulted with the Department of Corrections and the Board of Crime Control, those agencies are in agreement that it would be more appropriate to the functions of the Council and the respective agencies to attach the Council to the Board of Crime Control for administrative purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Brian Schweitzer, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws and the Constitution of the State of Montana, do hereby direct that the Concealed Weapon Advisory Council, created in accordance with Mont. Code Ann. § 45-8-329, be attached for administrative purposes only, as described in Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-121, to the Board of Crime Control provided for in Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-2006. Accordingly, the Board of Crime Control shall provide general administrative support for the Council, as necessary, within its existing resources, and perform the other administrative responsibilities to the Council as provided in Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-121.
