EXECUTIVE ORDER EXTENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 2-2012, EXCEPTING THE
TRANSPORT OF BALED LIVESTOCK FEED FROM CERTAIN TIME, SIZE, AND
WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS ON ALL HIGHWAYS IN MONTANA, EXCEPT THOSE
THAT ARE PART OF THE FEDERAL AID INTERSTATE SYSTEM, FOR AN
ADDITIONAL 31 DAYS UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2012

Whereas, I signed Executive Order 2-2012, excepting the transport of baled livestock feed from certain time, size, and weight restrictions on all highways in Montana, except those that are part of the federal aid interstate system on August 28, 2012; and

Whereas, that order expires on November 30, 2012; and


Whereas, the conditions and justification for the original order continue to exist; and

Whereas, the Director of the Department of Transportation has requested that I continue the Executive Order until the end of 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Brian Schweitzer, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the laws and Constitution of the State of Montana, due to the emergency circumstances above-described and described in Executive Order 2-2012, do hereby Extend Executive Order 2-2012 through December 31, 2012, unless otherwise ordered.

This Order is effective immediately.
